

NOT ONLY DOES IT MAKE CARS, NOW BENTLEY WILL BUILD ITS FIRST RESIDENTIAL TOWER IN MIAMI

Home to the Porsche Design Tower and Aston Martin Residences, Miami will now house the British automaker's first residential tower, Bentley.



Buildings bearing the hallmarks of major automotive brands are becoming increasingly popular, particularly in Miami, home to the **Porsche Design Tower** and **Aston Martin Residences**. Now another luxury carmaker is adding its name to that illustrious list: **Bentley Motors**, which announced it will build a 749-foot-tall building in the Sunny Isles Beach area.

Bentley has partnered with **Dezer Development** for the project, which will be the British manufacturer's first luxury residential tower.

Dezer's resume includes the Armani / Casa and Porsche towers. He partnered with **Sieger Suarez Architects** for both projects; the company will also supervise the design of the new construction of the assembly plant.

Outside of your condo, shared amenities include a gym, pool, spa, restaurant, lounge, cabanas, movie theater, whiskey bar, and landscaped garden.

Bentley Residences Miami will be built in accordance with Florida Green Building Council certifications; the hope is that, in this way, the building consumes less energy and has a minimal impact on the environment.
